Lexington Clinic offers lung cancer screenings using CT scans involving no-contrast dye and minimal exposure to radiation.

CRITERIA FOR LUNG CANCER SCREENINGS:

Adults age 55-80 years old* who:

- Currently have a 30 pack-year cigarette smoking history;
- Currently smoke or have quit within the past 15 years;
- Currently are asymptomatic and have no signs or symptoms of lung cancer.

*If you are 55-77 years old and have Medicare coverage, you may qualify to receive this screening at no cost to you.
